

## The State of the Man


### The State of Man

Jesus is the Creator of all the visible and invisible. **(Colossians 1:15-19)**


### The State of Man



The first graphic is a square, representing the soul of man in this visible world. Man is born in innocence; "the kingdom of God belongs to such as these..." - Matthew 19:14

**Children** - Their angels in heavens always see the face of my Father who is in Heaven... **(Matthew 18:1-10)**

## The State of Man



The souls burdened with iniquity are trapped in the Kingdom of Satan, which operates in the visible world through those who are subjects to their sin and obey their carnal desires.

**Sin** - is wrongdoing (**1 John 3:4**)

**Kingdom of Satan** - All those who continue in sin will not inherit the kingdom of God (**Galatians 5:19-21**)

**World** - Men loved more the darkness... (**John 3:19**)

\* Sin brings division between you and God (**Isaiah 59:1-2**)


## The State of Man



Upon death, those souls loaded with sin will suffer in Tartarus, the part of Hades where there is no rest, not even in death (*Luke 16:19-31*). The innocent souls will enjoy freedom from the limitations of the flesh in Paradise.

**Physical death** - All are destined to die and then face judgment. (*Hebrews 9:27*)

**Hades** - Invisible place where souls live without a body. (*Luke 16:19-31*)



Souls stained in sin have opportunity of being freed from their sin and be rehabilitated in innocence by means of the kingdom of God on Earth, the church. There is only one way you can belong to the church of Jesus, and be saved. It is by means of the Gospel, represented by the key and the acronym: HBRCB\*. Those who enter the Kingdom will enjoy Paradise upon their death. Those who are still enslaved to sin, even in the Kingdom of God, will suffer in Tartarus if they don't repent before their death.

**Paradise** - When Jesus died, He went to paradise. (Luke 23:43)  
Abraham is also in paradise. (Luke 16:19-31)

**Great fixed gulf** - Divides Paradise from Tartarus (torments) (Luke 16:19-31)


**Torments** (Greek *Tartaroos*) - Place of punishment and suffering until the final judgment (Jude 6; 2 Peter 2:4 [*Tartaroos* in the Greek translated as *Hell*])

**Kingdom of God** - Those freed from darkness (Kingdom of Satan) are here.  
(Ephesians 2: 1-5) (Colossians 1:13)

\***HBRCB** - When you **H**ear, **B**elieve, **R**epent, **C**onfess and are **B**aptized, you enter the Kingdom of God. Once there you need to persevere until death. (Romans 6:23; 13:12)

\* Only through the church can you be assured to arrive at paradise if you're an adult.



All will be resurrected on **JUDGMENT DAY**, the just to eternity and the unjust to their 2nd death. (Revelation 2:11; 20:6)


**New Jerusalem** - Eternal life with Christ and God. (Revelation 3:12)  
**2nd DEATH** - in the fire of Gehenna, apart from God for ever (Ezekiel 18:20)




On Judgment Day all souls will be resurrected in their carnal bodies. These bodies will then be transformed into celestial, eternal bodies. Those waiting in Tartarus go to their second death in the lake of fire forever, and those waiting in Paradise will go to their celestial dwelling to enjoy the glory of God forever!

Your body will be changed in an instant. If you lived for Christ you will live in eternal bliss, but if you suffered in torments (Tartarus) you will go to your second death in the lake of fire.

**(Rom 14:12, Mat 25:46, John 5:28-29; Revelation 21:8)**



All temporary and visible things will be destroyed. Also, Hades, which is temporary, will be consumed in the lake of fire.  
**(Hebrews 12:22-28, 2 Peter 3:10; Revelation 20:14)**



Only the ETERNAL will remain.




