 - b. The Blood of Jesus cleanses the conscience (14)

 - i. Needs contact with the blood to be cleansed
 - ii. We obtain contact with the blood through baptism

 - 1. Death of testator needs to be proven for will to take effect (16-17)

 - 1. Blood was necessary to purify the copies, heavenly things needed a better sacrifice (23)
 - 2. Jesus entered heaven itself to appear for us in God's presence (24)
 - B. The One-Time Sacrifice of Christ (25-28)
 - 1. He didn't need to do it multiple times with blood that is not His own (25)
 - 2. He appeared once for all to do away with sin (26)
 - 3. People die once and face judgment (27)
 - 4. Christ was sacrificed once to take the sins of many and will appear a second time to bring salvation for those who are waiting for Him (28)
